Introduction

Overview

The Level 5 International Diploma in Transport Management is an all-in-one course designed for professionals wishing to broaden their expertise in the logistics and transport management. The course has a wide range of topics covering fundamentals of transport, transport operations and transport planning techniques.

Who is this for?

The Level 5 Diploma in Transport Management is aimed at individuals working at managerial or supervisory level involved in planning and implementation of transport operations.

Learners from non-business graduation background but planning to begin a warehousing career can also benefit from this course.

Course Content

Mandatory Unit

PD01 Management in Logistics and Transport

This unit presents the fundamental management knowledge required of managers in logistics and the transport industry. It covers aspects of the internal and external structures of an organisation, the governance of the people within the organisation and those financial and other planning techniques necessary to maintain organisational health. It aims to deliver the understanding and competence of those key elements of management practice that are fundamental to both commercial and non-commercial organisations.

Elective Units

PD03 Transport Operations

This unit provides the basis for professionals in the transport industry to understand the principles of effective, safe and legal movement of goods and people by the principal modes in a national and international context. The unit covers the nature of transport, an appreciation of its supply and demand characteristics and the different ways in which the transport product can be delivered effectively and efficiently.

PD04 Transport Planning

This unit presents the key generic aspects of transport planning. It provides foundation knowledge on the concepts and principles that govern the transport planning process. The unit investigates the nature and purpose of transport planning, the interactions between transport and land use and the transport planning process.

Option Units

PD07 Movement of People

This unit provides the underlying knowledge for the movement of people in national and international contexts. It addresses the responses of the operator of passenger transport to the characteristics of movements. Key elements are: the operation of the interchange points and location together with the vital communications links that supply the control and confirmation of movement.

PD11 Transport Planning Techniques

This unit presents the technical processes involved in transport planning. It provides technical knowledge on the quantitative processes that underpin the transport planning. It incorporates the development of strategic plans at national, regional and local levels.

PD12 Transport and Society

This unit addresses the issues surrounding transport and its relationship with society. It reviews the impact of demography, politics and environmental factors on the development of transport for both passengers and freight. Further key elements are: the effect of residential choices and employment patterns on transport needs.

Total Learning Time

The learning time is set at 360 hours as self-study hours. This is allocated as 90 hours for each of the 4 units.



Assessment

To achieve this qualification Learners must complete four units. Completion of the Mandatory Management unit and one elective unit is compulsory, and Learners must take two option units. The units will be assessed by a time-constrained, unseen examination conducted under closed-book arrangements. This will consist of a single paper of three hours duration for each unit.

Learners will be given the opportunity of two re-sits per examination. If after two re-sits Learners do not achieve a pass, then they will be required to re-register on the qualification to continue.

The overall pass mark for each examination is 50%

Registration

Registration Period

The registration period for this qualification is 1 year, which is the period in which a Learner is expected to complete the qualification.

Registration Extension

At the end of the registration period all Learners will be withdrawn from the relevant qualification.

However, if an extension is required, learners must contact the CILT to request this.

Please note that there is a fee chargeable for each extension / re-registration.

Progression

Learners can progress from the CILT Level 5 International Diploma in Transport Management to the CILT International Level 6 Advanced Diploma.
